FROM THE PASTOR'S PEN

TOWN HALL MEETING

Next weekend we're holding a town hall meeting. Everyone from both campuses of our parish is invited to attend.

We will meet at St. Philip the Apostle Church starting at 10:30 a.m. We will begin shortly after the 9:30 a.m. Mass has ended.

What's the focus of this town hall? Well, every year the staff meets with the Episcopal Vicar for our area, Bishop Bartosic. At our last annual meeting with him, we prepared a slide show detailing how far we've come in the transition to a new, combined parish. It contained a lot of information.

We'd like the opportunity to share that same slide presentation at the town hall meeting. It goes for about 25 minutes. In addition, we're adding a few slides at the beginning, mostly from the Archdiocesan priest days that explain why we need to pursue Renew My Church, that is, why change is needed.

We think you'll find all of this informative and interesting. It may spark some questions that you'd like to ask us, as well as some good discussion. Please join me and a number of staff members for this town hall meeting.

SEARCH COMMITTEE

Two weekends ago in my column, I announced the impending retirement of Todd Gresick, our parish Director of Music. Todd had informed me that this coming February, when he turns 65 years of age, he will retire from full-time ministry. While we are happy that he is in good health and is in a position to enjoy his retirement years, we are also

sad to be losing a fantastic and talented staff member who has given so much to the parish.

We are in the process of forming a search committee that represents the various constituencies involved in parish music: the adult choir, the Saturday evening ensemble, the cantors, the associate music minister (Sarah), the lead musician for Sunday evening (Matthieu), and the parish at large. When I hear back from everyone on their willingness and availability to serve on the search committee, I'll share with you more information on the committee itself and the search process.

At this point, know that we will leave no stone unturned in attempting to find a suitable successor. The search will be a national one and the interview process will be kindly but rigorous.

As a footnote to all this: some other things have to fall into place fairly quickly as an adjunct to the search for a new Director of Liturgy and Music (yes, we'd like to hire an individual who would serve in a dual position, if possible - put the emphasis on that little word "if"). Those things are 1) a revised job description for the dual position, and 2) a decision by the Senior Leadership Team and the Parish Council on a new Mass schedule (because we can not hardly interview candidates without knowing how many Masses they are going to be responsible for).

More on this subject matter as we go forward. Thanks!

Cost is \$5 per person to cover the costs of the musicians.

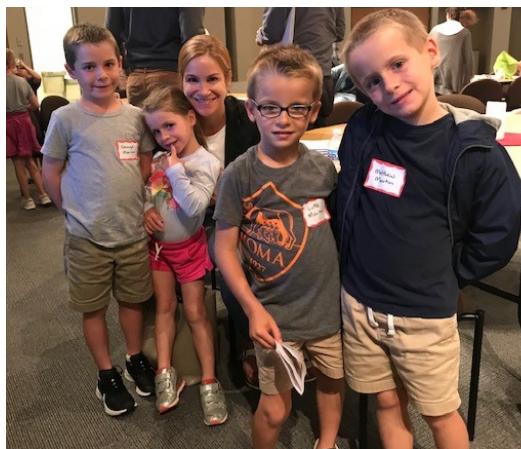

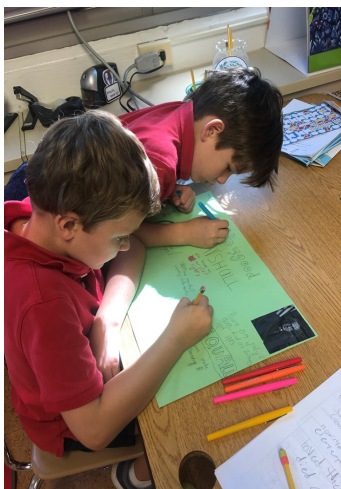
