



CONTEMPLATIVE VISION FOR OUR TIMES: AN INTRODUCTORY PROGRAM TO CENTERING PRAYER

Saturday October 30, 2021 9:00 am. - 3:00 pm.

What is a Centering Prayer? It is a contemporary form of prayer of the heart; a prayer of simplicity and faith. It's a method of reducing the obstacles to the gifts of contemplative prayer, and of facilitating the development of habits conducive to responding to the inspiration of the Holy Spirit.



A contemplative prayer is a development of one's relationship with Christ to the point of communing beyond words, thoughts, and feelings; a process of moving the simplified activity of waiting upon God to the ever-increasing dominance of the gifts of the Spirit, as the source of one's prayer.

This introductory program includes the methods leading to the contemplative prayer in Spiritual Journey.

- The Centering Prayer Method and a Centering Prayer Session. Video and Discussion


