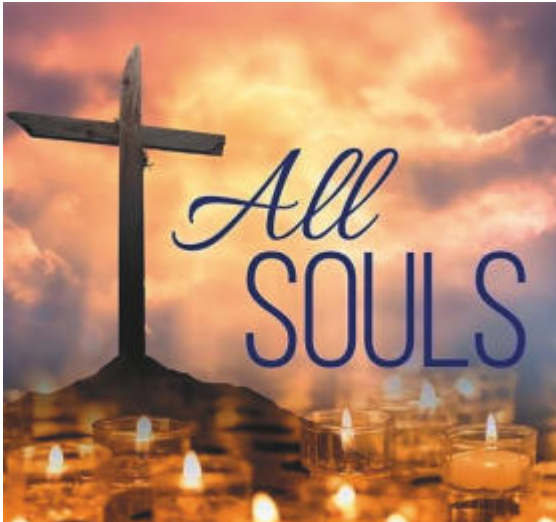

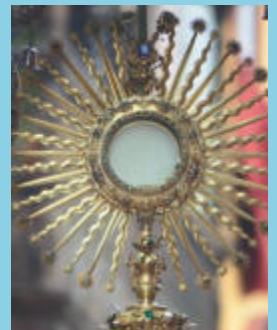
The Book of Remembrance also will be displayed for you to write in the names of your loved ones, which will be remembered at the All Soul's Day Mass.

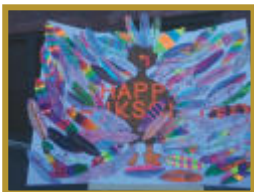

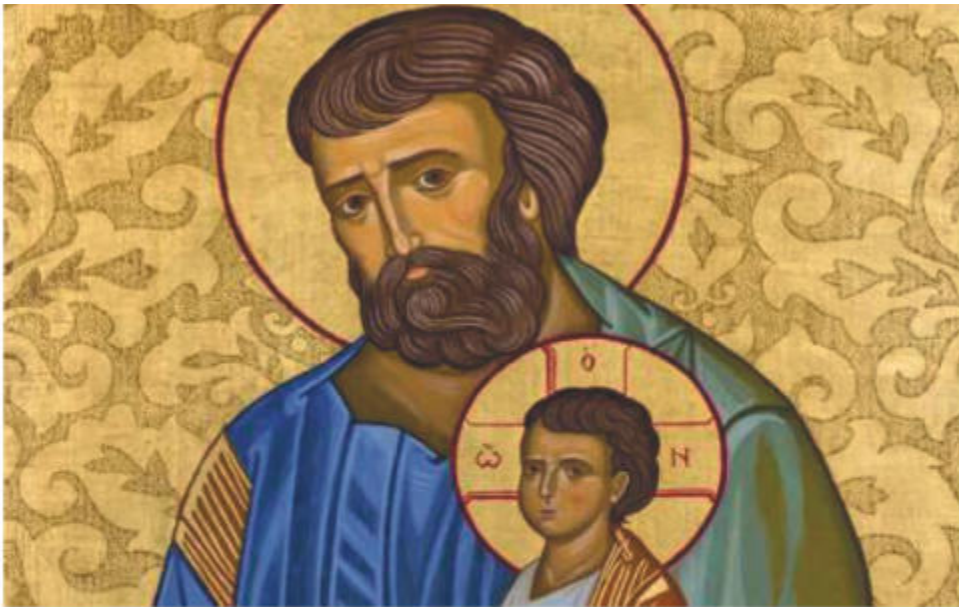

The Junior Kindergartners love their dress up station this year!



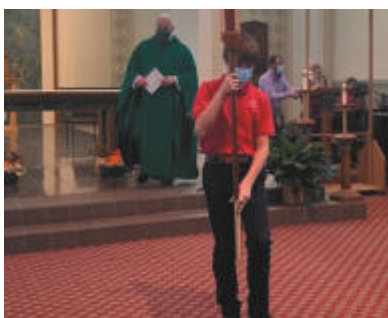

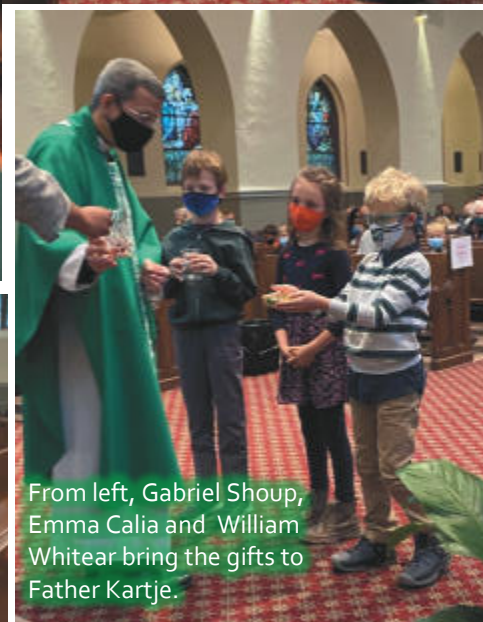
