FROM THE PASTOR'S PEN

DISCIPLESHIP AND ADVENT

If you've heard a few of my homilies over the past couple of years you know that I speak about being disciples a lot. By faith we have inherited the mantle of discipleship from those original Twelve disciples of Jesus.

To my mind, there is nothing more important than being a disciple of Jesus. It implies that we have a close relationship with him. The Lord is a person whom we follow and to whom we relate as we follow him.

This, in turn, means that we are not embracing an idea or a program. We are embracing a person who is Risen, alive and well, Someone to whom we can relate right here and right now.

Jesus is not merely an historical figure that we read about who lived long ago. He is living because he is Risen and he is present in our lives through the action of the Holy Spirit. He promised us, his disciples, to be with us always; he would not abandon us.



How do we cultivate this living relationship with the Lord Jesus? There are a whole bunch of avenues and tools available for us to do so in our Catholic tradition.

- We can read and study Scripture, especially the New Testament.
- We can join a small faith-sharing group for support and help in living the Christian life.
- We can celebrate sacraments, especially Reconciliation and the

Eucharist.

- We can dedicate a portion of each day to prayer using formulaic prayers from our tradition, like the Rosary, or we can peruse the words of Scripture, or we can simply talk to God as we would a friend.
- We can engage in spiritual direction.
- We can go on a retreat.
- We can keep a spiritual journal.
- We can learn about the lives of the saints.
- We can read and explore all sorts of useful spiritual books.

These are just a few ideas on deepening our discipleship and fine-tuning our relationship with the Lord Jesus. As with any relationship, it takes work and energy and development over time.

Our discipleship is not something that will ever be perfected in this life. We will get distracted. We will go off course. We will even sometimes keep Jesus at bay, like we do with other friends of ours.

The good news is that the journey of discipleship never stops. It is a journey of a lifetime.

That's one of the meanings of Advent.

The journey of discipleship is never accomplished. The whole

point is that it is precisely a journey. It will have twists and turns, like any relationship. It will morph, and grow, and mature even as we ourselves morph and grow and mature over the years.

Advent is only four weeks. But it can be a powerful four weeks that lead us to the joy of Christmas and the celebration of God being born in our lives.

The liturgical season of Advent is only



four weeks. But our looking forward as disciples to the fullness of Christ and his kingdom is a life-time adventure, an adventure that, for us, will not stop this side of heaven.

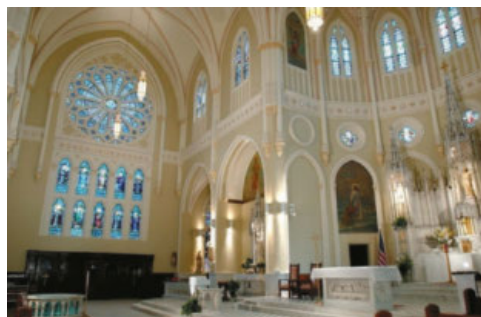

JOIN US FOR OUR NEW CONTEMPLATIVE MASS ON SUNDAYS AT 4:30 P.M. AT SACRED HEART CHURCH

With the earlier darkness and the liturgical focus of Advent just weeks away, we have introduced a contemplative ambience to the 4:30 p.m. Mass. Elements of this contemplative ambience include dim, softer lighting with the use of candles to enhance our worship space, music that is more chant or Taizé like, and a tone that encourages us to slow down and focus our attention on the presence of the Lord around us and within us.



Contemplation calms our mind and spirit. It will provide a wonderful way to center us in our activities for the coming weeks during this busy time of year.

You'll notice a few changes to the Mass that will help create this new ambience and help us to dwell deeply in Christ's presence around and

within us. We encourage you to limit conversation with other worshipers around you as soon as you enter your pew. You'll notice the Priest (and Deacon if he is present) will already be seated on the altar, sitting still, listening to the Lord. The assembly is invited to do the same. The Entrance Song is started, and when indicated by the Priest, we are invited to stand and begin with the familiar words "In the name of the Father ...". The other parts of the Mass remain unchanged. They simply incorporate this theme of contemplation.

We invite you to come experience the "new" 4:30 p.m. Mass, and dwell in the quiet love of the Lord.
