#### FROM THE PASTOR'S PEN

#### STEWARDSHIP REPORT

Our annual report to you gives you a general sense of the state of the parish, as well as the end of the fiscal year financial picture. It's available on our website. There are some hardcopies of the report available at the back of both churches as well.

We try and monitor when we run out of hardcopies. If you can't find any, let us know and we'll print up more copies.

On the front cover of the report you'll see a quote from the New Testament, from 1 Timothy 6:18-19. It reads, "Tell them to do good, to be rich in good works, to be generous, ready to share, thus accumulating as treasure a good foundation for the future, so as to win the life that is true life."

The report details the great generosity of members and friends of this parish. Charitable collections apart from the second collections totaled \$130,344. This beautiful outreach was shared last year with A Just Harvest, St. Benedict the African Parish, St. Moses the Black Parish (formerly St. Columbanus), the Father Paul Foundation (Sri Lanka), and our sister community in Haiti, St. Jean Baptiste Parish. In addition to this outreach, we generously shared with a variety of needs through the second collections, all of which totaled \$161,188 last year.

We are encouraged by Paul's Letter to Timothy to be generous. This parish has consistently heeded this advice.

The parish community is meant to go beyond itself in service to others who need our help and assistance. We do give help in a variety of ways, not just sharing financial gifts with others.

One of the most promising innovative moves in Children's Ministry is how we now build experiential service opportunities into every level of the program. Children's Ministry and

Sacred Heart School have done this in the past, but now plan intentional opportunities for young people to serve the needs of those less fortunate into the very structure of their year.

I am deeply grateful for the initiative, creativity, and generosity shown by our parishioners. This is an amazing community with a very kind heart with two wonderful houses of worship that generate a continuous flow of goodness toward those who need it the most in today's world. Divine Mercy Parish is truly merciful. We do not hoard or hold onto the gifts of God but share with others. This is what it means to be immersed in "true life," the life God cultivates within us as his Son's disciples.

Let's always be mindful of our vision,



the challenging vision to which we aspire as faithful members of this beautiful parish:

Divine Mercy Parish is a welcoming community that inspires disciples of Jesus to share God's love and transform the world.



# JOIN US FOR EUCHARISTIC ADORATION AT BOTH OUR CHURCHES DURING FEBRUARY

Join us on Wednesday afternoons at Sacred Heart Church from 2-3:00 p.m. for Adoration and recitation of the Rosary.



We'll also gather at St. Philip the Apostle Church on Friday mornings after the 8:00 a.m. Mass (typically 8:30 - 9:30 a.m.) for Adoration and recitation of the Rosary as well.

Our faith community also gathers at St. Philip the Apostle on Tuesday mornings after the 8:00 a.m. Mass to say the Rosary.

From the Oblates of the Virgin Mary:

"What is Eucharistic Adoration?" That's a question we often hear from those new to the faith or searching for ways to deepen their relationship with Jesus Christ. Adoration is a way to be present with the Lord and focus on actively listening to His word through prayer.

During Eucharistic Adoration, the faithful pray to Jesus Christ, who is present in the Eucharist. The Eucharist, also referred to as the Blessed Sacrament, is typically kept in a tabernacle at your parish church.

While it is true that you can pray to God anywhere and that He is always within you, it is especially powerful to adore Jesus in the Eucharist. In the presence of the Eucharist, we pray to the power and sacrifice that it represents — the body of Jesus, who gave His life so that we may live.

It is His body, blood, soul and divinity that is really, truly, and substantially present in the Eucharist.

We adore and receive the Eucharist in communion at Mass, which is the most beautiful act of worship that we have as Catholics. We have Jesus truly present in all of the tabernacles around the world. We can continue to adore Him in the Eucharist after Mass in a quiet time of prayer and contemplation on Who we have just received. Being in the presence of the body, blood, soul and divinity of Jesus Christ gives spiritual strength and nourishment in a uniquely powerful way."

We hope you'll join us, and spend some time with Jesus. Our world and our Church need so many prayers today!



8th Grade has been




