FROM THE PASTOR'S PEN

OUR PLAN FOR THE FUTURE Part Four

Last weekend I wrote to you about how the current state of affairs of organized religion represents an opportunity. It represents an opportunity for us to share the Good News of Jesus Christ to those who are skeptical, indifferent, or who have turned their back on religion, any organized religion, not just Christianity.

The strategic plan put together by the Parish Council recognizes this opportunity in front of us. The members of the Council engaged in a ton of hard work to arrive at the plan.

I thought I'd share with you the thoughts of Council members as they looked back at their experience of the past two years as they worked to craft the strategic plan. I asked each of them to complete the following open-ended statement: "What I liked most about the planning process for the strategic plan was. . . ."

Here's what they had to say.

What I liked the most about the planning process for the strategic plan was. . .

. . . experiencing how differently, and occasionally unpredictably, our thinking was on so many issues, but how, over time, through commitment to our parish, and the greater Church, through the power of prayer and the frequent intercession of the Holy Spirit, we were able to find common ground.

. . . seeing how passionate each council member was about our parish and our future, and how often the Holy Spirit would direct us to unexpected places.

. . . the energy around making Divine Mercy a parish that attracts and welcomes all people.

. . . the enthusiastic realization by all

council members of what our parish needs are, and how much could be accomplished with the engagement of fellow parishioners.

. . . envisioning all the wonderful possibilities for our beloved parish and the greater Church as we continue this necessary path of renewal.

. . . interacting with the other members and debating ideas to sustain and revitalize the parish.

. . . the opportunity to step back and think about what's important, what's needed to re-energize the parish.

. . . the opportunity to work together on a plan to help our parish flourish.

. . . the dedication and commitment of the council members to truly make Divine Mercy a parish that lives its vision statement.

. . . the chance to make a difference in our parish journey.

To reiterate:

This is an unpredictable journey. The Holy Spirit is moving us forward passionately, enthusiastically, with energy, vision, love, debate, and dedication to unexpected places, where we will, as a parish, make a difference, and flourish.

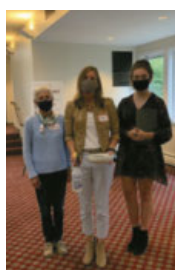

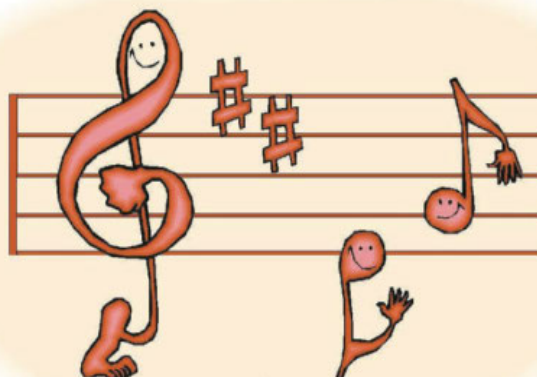
