#### FROM THE PASTOR'S PEN

## OUR PLAN FOR THE FUTURE Part Five

In last week's column I shared comments from various Parish Council members regarding what they liked most about the process which produced the strategic plan. I hope you were excited by those comments, their variety and how they captured the ups and downs of the planning process.

There surely were ups and downs in the process. How could there not be?

It was rather like a family meeting where members shared their thoughts and feelings on how and what the family should be focused in the near future. Every person in that kind of discussion usually owns and expresses strong opinions, feelings and thoughts. That goes for a parish, too.

A parish is a type of family - a family of faith.

One's family of origin or biological family is usually knit together by genetics (or adoption!), whereas a parish family is created and brought together by the Holy Spirit. We believe it.

Think about it. The Holy Spirit has brought us together in a variety of ways and by lavishing gifts upon us that draw us closer to one another and to the kingdom: gifts of sacrament, scripture, tradition, ritual, and prayer. Go ahead! Add to that list. It's not exhaustive. Can the gifts of the Holy Spirit ever be exhausted?

One of the reasons why the Parish Council's strategic planning process took as long as it did, is because the members of the Parish Council needed to listen to each other carefully, and in doing so, listen to the promptings of the Holy Spirit. If listening to the Spirit was always easy or simple, like reading a text message or getting an email, the plan would have been put together in no time.

Listening carefully under the influence of the Holy Spirit requires patience and discernment. If any of you are in regular spiritual direction, you know that discernment is an ongoing process, actually a neverending process of sifting through one's experience for the call of God.

That's why the planning process took as long as it did. It's also why the process, in some regards, won't really ever stop. Yes, we have priorities and goals under this strategic plan.

But because it is a five-year plan, the Council will evaluate the implementation of the plan year-by-year, and then based on that evaluation, tweak it, amend it, and work with it so that we stay attuned to the call of God as a parish. In other words, the elements of the plan are clear and concrete, but those elements are also meant to be flexible.

Just as each believer and disciple is challenged to listen to the promptings of the Holy Spirit, our Parish Council also will be challenged over the years as the plan unfolds to continue to listen to the Spirit. To me, that makes this an exciting proposition.

I'll offer you another image: if this parish were a sailboat on Lake Michigan, it would require the crew to pay attention to shifting winds, water conditions, and other weather features to sail the ship along the lake to its desired destination.

Our desired destination is what guides this parish as it sails along. That destination is encompassed by our Vision Statement, "Divine Mercy Parish is a welcoming community that inspires disciples of Jesus to share God's love and transform the world."

How we arrive at that beautiful destination will require us to implement the strategic plan, yes,



but to continually listen to each other, pray, discern and embrace what's over the horizon in this spirited adventure to which God calls us.

### BE STILL AND KNOW THAT I AM GOD - PSALM 46:10

#### Discover Contemplative, Centering Prayer!

In the Christian tradition contemplative prayer is considered to be pure gift of God. It is the opening of mind and heart—our whole being, to God, the Ultimate Mystery, beyond thoughts, words, and emotions. Through grace we open our awareness to God whom we know by faith is within us, closer than breathing, thinking, choosing, and closer than consciousness itself.

Centering Prayer is a method designed to facilitate the development of contemplative prayer by preparing our faculties to receive this gift. Centering prayer is not meant to replace other kinds of prayer: rather it casts a new light and depth of meaning on them. It is at the same time a relationship with God and a discipline to foster that relationship. This method of prayer is a movement beyond conversation with Christ to communion with Him. The source of Centering Prayer is the indwelling Trinity: Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. The focus of Centering Prayer is the deepening of our relationship with the Living, Universal Christ today!
