

FROM THE PASTOR'S PEN

OUR PLAN FOR THE FUTURE Part Six

For the past five weeks I've been writing in this column about the parish strategic plan which has been developed by the Parish Council. The next step in the unveiling of the plan will occur on Saturday when the Parish Council, Finance Council, the staff, the Senior Leadership Team and members from all of our parish boards will meet.

The purpose of the meeting is to afford board members an overview of the planning process and then apprise them of the plan itself, all with an eye toward the implementation of the strategic plan across all parts of the parish. I would ask everyone to please pray that the Holy Spirit enlighten and quide us as we meet.

With that request in mind, let me remind us all of a portion of the Renew My Church prayer, the portion that calls upon the Holy Spirit:

- to hear the promptings of the Spirit:
- to listen to each other attentively;

BE STILL AND KNOW THAT I AM GOD - PSALM 46:10 Discover Contemplative, Centering Prayer!

In the Christian tradition contemplative prayer is considered to be pure gift of God. It is the opening of mind and heart—our whole being, to God, the Ultimate Mystery, beyond thoughts, words, and emotions. Through grace we open our awareness to God whom we know by faith is within us, closer than breathing, thinking, choosing, and closer than consciousness itself.

Centering Prayer is a method designed to facilitate the development of contemplative prayer by preparing our faculties to receive this gift. Centering prayer is not meant to replace other kinds of prayer: rather it casts a new light and depth of meaning on them. It is at the same time a relationship with God and a discipline to foster that relationship. This method of prayer is a movement beyond conversation with Christ to communion with Him. The source of Centering Prayer is the indwelling Trinity: Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. The focus of Centering Prayer is the deepening of our relationship with the Living, Universal Christ today!
