We are excited to announce that Children's Liturgy of the Word (CLOW) is returning to Sunday 10 a.m. Mass at Sacred Heart beginning **Sunday, September 10, 2023**! CLOW, as you may know, occurs right before the Liturgy of the Word during Mass, where two leaders take children PK-2nd grade out of Mass to the Chapel in the Parish Office and read the gospel story (from the Children's Bible) thereby giving them an opportunity to reflect on the story from the bible AND stretch their legs. (And their parents a chance to hear the readings and homily!)

We need several leaders and want to make it fun for the children. (The leaders can be a parent along with their junior high or high school student.) They'll not only read from the Bible, they may sing songs, and learn to pray and offer child-friendly intentions.


