### PASTOR'S "TO THE POINT"



This weekend we kick off Children's Ministry. Watch for kids and their families at the 10:00 a.m. Mass.

We've got a great, energetic and creative ministry for kids helped by Kathy Handelman and Kelly Shoup. Our catechists are very dedicated. They are helped by teen assistants, which by the way, grows each year.

More and more teens are signing up to help, which is a real positive sign! The younger kids truly look up to them and enjoy their presence.

This is Year Two of our parish strategic plan, The Way Forward. One of the specific ways forward for us as a parish is to nurture and strengthen the bonds of unity that make us one in Christ, bonds visibly seen in the commitment of families, catechists, kids, and teens drawing together to meet Jesus and become his disciples, younger and older.

### PARTY IN THE PARK PROCEEDS TO BENEFIT SOUND SYSTEM IMPROVEMENTS IN OUR CHURCHES

Why are these improvements necessary? Haven't we already made upgrades during recent years?

To answer these questions, we want to share some background information. Indeed, we have made improvements to the systems at both churches in recent years, including upgrades that enabled us to introduce livestream capabilities during the Covid pandemic.

We are once again facing the need for replacement of components and enhancements to our technology. In general, church sound systems get a real workout, and we are seeing this firsthand at both of our sites.

We have enlisted the expertise of trusted professionals who are working to identify specific solutions to our problems, while at the same time kindly providing us with loaner equipment until we decide upon a course of action.

At this point, we need to purchase a new power amplifier and digital processor for the St. Philip the Apostle church, along with some new presider microphones. At the same time, we are working to develop a solution for the poor acoustics that continue to plague Sacred Heart church. The estimates for these improvements start at \$20,000 and will most likely be upwards of \$50,000.

We thank you in advance for your support of our efforts to make sound at Mass, and other events at our beautiful churches, the best it can be!

## Parish Survey Findings

During the first quarter of 2023, the parishioners of Divine Mercy were asked to participate in the Archdiocesan-wide Disciple Maker Index Survey, which gave people an opportunity to reflect on their spiritual growth, level of involvement in the parish, as well as their satisfaction with the parish and parish related activities. Approximately 54 percent of our active\* parishioners completed the survey. (That's 235 completed surveys out of 435 average weekend mass-goers.) Thank you for taking the time to share your thoughts. We appreciate your efforts in providing the parish with valuable insights into how we can enhance our faith and service-based community. Below is a brief overview of the survey findings. ### PARISH STRENGTHS

Based on the survey data, we have identified our top parish strengths.

*The following percentages show those who answered "agree or strongly agree" for each question.*

**90%**

know that scripture is the word of God.

**87%**

make time daily or weekly for individual prayer time.

**87%**

believe that the Eucharist is the Body and Blood of Christ.

**78%**

attend Mass weekly, with some attending daily.

**86%**

feel our parish communicates well and makes information readily available.

**75%**

understand that the Church is critical to their relationship with God.

We will explore ways to ensure that preaching and **homilies connect faith with everyday life.**

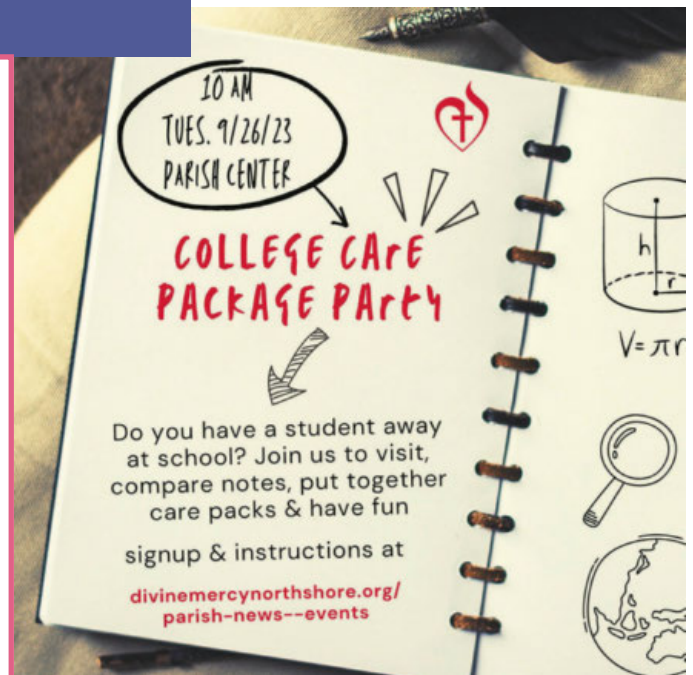

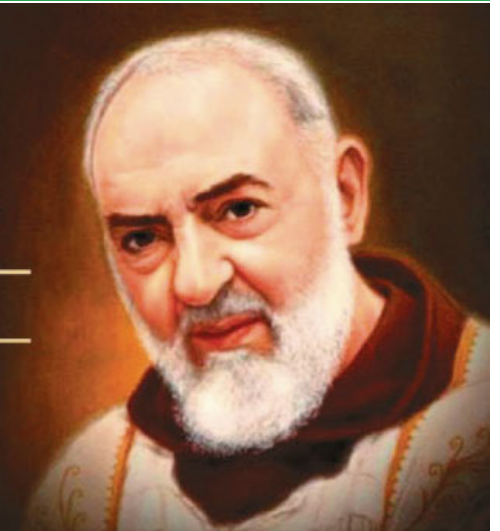

## PADRE PIO

September 23rd



On Sept. 23, we remember the Italian Franciscan priest St. Pio of Petrelcina, better known as "Padre Pio" and known for his suffering, humility and miracles. The man later known by these names was originally named Francesco Forgione, born to his parents Grazio and Maria in 1887. His parents had seven children, two of whom died in infancy. They taught the five surviving children to live their faith through daily Mass, family prayer of the rosary, and regular acts of penance. Francesco had already decided at a young age to dedicate his entire life to God. At age 10, he felt inspired by the example of a young Capuchin Franciscan, and told his parents: "I want to be a friar – with a beard." Francesco's father spent time in America, working to finance his son's education so he could enter the religious life. On Jan. 22, 1903, Francesco donned the Franciscan habit for the first time. He took the new name Pio, a modernized Italian form of "Pius," in honor of Pope St. Pius V. He made his solemn vows four years later, and received priestly ordination in the summer of 1910. Shortly after, he first received the Stigmata – Christ's wounds, present in his own flesh. Known for patient suffering, fervent prayer, and compassionate spiritual guidance, Padre Pio also lent his efforts to the establishment of a major hospital, the "Home to Relieve Suffering." Padre Pio died in 1968, and was declared a saint in 2002. Three years after his death, Pope Paul VI marveled at his simple and holy life in an address to the Capuchin Order.
