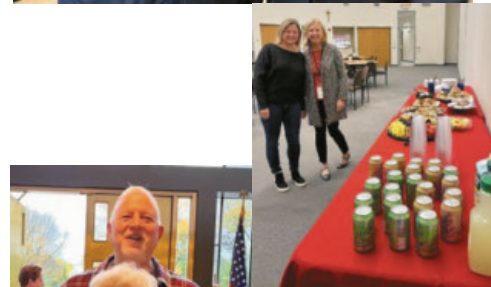

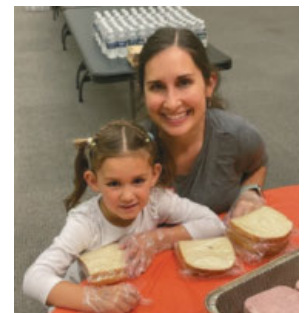

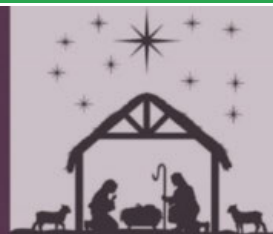

CATHOLIC CAMPAIGN FOR HUMAN DEVELOPMENT

Next weekend, our parish will take up the annual collection for the Catholic Campaign for Human Development, also known as CCHD. For over 50 years, the mission of CCHD has been to address the root causes of poverty in the United States through the promotion and support of organizations that help people help themselves. CCHD supports these local groups as they create jobs, improve neighborhoods, keep schools safe and enriching for children, and raise leaders for the future. CCHD-sponsored programs effectively break the cycle of poverty by building collective power so that people can take action on the issues that affect their lives, families and communities.

Last year, parishes across the Archdiocese of Chicago raised \$380,753.68 during collection weekend. Next week, we have the ability to sow tangible seeds of hope by contributing to the Catholic Campaign for Human Development.
