PASTOR'S "TO THE POINT"



At our October Parish Council meeting we had a lively discussion about some of the initiatives happening throughout the parish. It was a great discussion.

A new *Teen Council* has been formed and they are "off and running." They've had several meetings now to plan what they want to do together. All teens are invited to be a part of this Council.

We've got two different groups who engage in *Adoration Before the Blessed Sacrament*. One group meets at Sacred Heart Church on Wednesday afternoon. Another group meets at St. Philip the Apostle Church on Friday morning.

We've got several *faith sharing* groups that we know of operating within the parish, including a men's book discussion group that meets on Saturday mornings.

Children's Liturgy of the Word has started up again with trained lay presiders leading the kids. The little ones seem to like this effort which engages them at their level much better than what we can do at the adult assembly.

This is only a small snapshot of what's going on in Divine Mercy Parish. We've got a new ministry booklet that details all of the organized ministries of the parish. The Holy Spirit is at work helping us to help others and make a difference for good in the world.

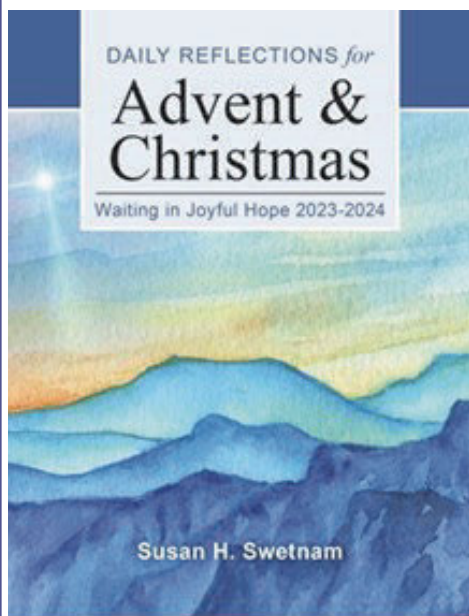

A JUST HARVEST NEEDS US

NOVEMBER 19TH

A Just Harvest offers daily lunch service for the homeless in the Rogers Park community, and Divine Mercy is scheduled to serve lunch on the third Sunday of the month, 11/19/23.

- 1) We need volunteers to prepare the food and deliver it to the Parish Center at Sacred Heart by noon on Saturday, 11/18/23.
- 2) We then need a delivery volunteer to take the food to A Just Harvest that afternoon. The delivery volunteer needs a car capable of transporting a lot of items.
- 3) Finally, we need serving volunteers (that must be at least 12 years old) that should arrive at A Just Harvest at 11 am on Sunday. We stay until approximately 2:30 pm.

All serving volunteers are asked to bring 2-3 gallons of whole or 2% milk, wear shirts with sleeves, jeans or pants, and closed-toe shoes.
