Dear Deacon McNulty,

The Vicar for Deacons has advised me that you have requested to be placed on retired status. It is clear that you have served well over these many years, and I wish to offer my heartfelt thanks to you for your dedication and loyalty.

Effective November 1, 2023, you will be listed as a retired deacon of the Archdiocese of Chicago. While retired deacons no longer have ministerial faculties, if an occasion arises where you would desire to celebrate a sacrament, you may request permission from the Vicar for the Diaconate. Faculties will normally be granted so long as you are in compliance with current Archdiocesan requirements for public ministry.

In the days ahead, I would be grateful for your remembrance of me in your prayers, and pray as well for vocations to diaconal ministry, and to the priesthood. In this way, you will continue as one of our deacons to assist me in bringing the love of the Lord to those we serve. 
# CHILDRENS MINISTRY SAINTS FAIR
