



#### FROM THE PASTOR'S PEN

#### **TIME FLIES**

It feels to me as if we just began the summer months. Yet here we are and it is the start of August. Soon enough, Sacred Heart School will be back in session, as well as our Children's Ministry. Families and individuals will be preparing for the end-of-summer activities, perhaps one final get away before we all get back to business.

While some of our parish ministries slowed down a bit and staff members were able to get away for some down time, the "business" of the parish never really stops. Masses continue. Baptisms and weddings take place. Some groups continue to meet.

On August 22 the 4:30 Sunday Mass will resume. That will bring us to our full complement of weekend Masses.

We keep hearing from some folks that Sunday early evening is a good time for them to celebrate Mass. My hope is that as we resume the Sunday evening Mass people will join in and make it a celebratory gathering at the close of each weekend.

## PREPARE TO HEAR GOD SPEAKING TO YOU

Whether you attend the soon-to-resume 4:30 Sunday Mass or whether you attend one of the other weekend Masses, a good way to make the liturgy more meaningful is to prepare ahead of time to hear the Word of God in scripture. There are all sorts of apps out there that you can install on your phone that will bring up the readings for Catholic weekday and weekend Masses.

Take a few minutes out of your busy

schedule and read through the scriptures for the upcoming Sunday. Even if you arrive early for Mass and do so, say 10 minutes prior to the start of Mass, it will help you be more receptive to the Word of God.

Ask yourself what words or phrases jump out at you, and reflect on why they do so. Is there something in one of the readings that you question or wonder about? Is there something in the Word of God that resonates with you or challenges you?

This sort of preparation simply tills the soil, so to speak. It enables you to hear the scriptures proclaimed in a new way, you come at them already percolating and reflecting. Then you hear the homily and your reflections may either be validated or challenged. No matter. Either way your experience of the liturgy will be enriched because of your prior preparation.

God may have a special message for you hidden within the scriptures for the weekend. On the other hand, prompted by your prior preparation, perhaps God's message will come to you because of a hymn that we sing, or in the responsorial psalm, or in the text of a prayer spoken at Mass.

God's Word is powerful and overflows from scripture into the entire liturgical experience. Personal preparation prior to the liturgy itself can only help bring to the surface God's consoling, challenging, affirming, empowering message.

#### STATEMENT OF CARDINAL BLASE CUPICH ON TRADITIONIS CUSTODES

I am grateful to Pope Francis for issuing on July 16, 2021, an apostolic letter entitled *Traditionis Custodes* ("Guardians of the Tradition"). His letter gives directions about the use of the liturgical forms prior to the reforms of 1970, that is, the use of the Roman Missal published under the auspices of Pope St. John XXIII in 1962. In doing so, Pope Francis follows a trajectory from Pope St. John Paul II through Pope Benedict XVI and into his own pontificate with regard to the use of this earlier Missal. His concern is the unity of the Church. Very properly, by entrusting the implementation of his directives to local diocesan bishops, he restores the principle that the bishop is the chief liturgist in the diocese.

In response to the letter I will take time to study, reflect and consult with others on it and in due time offer a pathway for implementing what the Holy Father has asked us to do, keeping in mind the principle of unity and the ability to appropriately authorize the use of the Missal of 1962. In the meanwhile, current practices with regard to the 1962 Missal remain in place.

My hope and prayer, as always and in communion with the Holy Father, is for the unity of the Church. I also pray that this will be an occasion for all of us to deepen our understanding and appreciation of the worship life of the Church, the Eucharist and the liturgical renewal of the Second Vatican Council which, St. Pope John Paul affirmed, represents the "movement of the Holy Spirit in the Church." Apostolic Letter, VICESIMUS QUINTUS ANNUS, 12, 1988.



#### Children's Ministry Sunday Morning Sessions

- Sessions will meet from 8:50-9:50 a.m. on Sundays at Sacred Heart School & Parish Center.
- We will hold Family Masses, retreats, sacraments, special sessions and more on both the St. Philip the Apostle campus and on the Sacred Heart campus.
- We will kick off our year with a Family Mass at 9:30 a.m., September 19th at St. Philip the Apostle Church followed by food and fellowship.
- Our year will feature:
  - 3 Family Masses
  - Service projects woven directly into the monthly curriculum based on the Corporal Works of Mercy for all grade levels
  - 1 Saints Celebration
  - 1 Christmas Pageant
  - Sessions led by our outstanding, experienced catechists
  - Youth Alpha for our 7<sup>th</sup> graders to better know the Life of Jesus
     Sacramental prep for our 2<sup>nd</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> graders.

#### **Family Faith Connections**

- We will bring back our monthly Family Faith Connections program for those families who want to learn, grow and pray together as an alternative to the regular weekly Children's Ministry sessions. Family Faith combines monthly group meetings on Sunday evenings at the Sacred Heart Parish Center and gradespecific instruction by trained catechists along with at-home sessions guided by parents.
- Families will gather 8 times per year on a Sunday evening from 5:15-7:00 p.m. to share a meal, prayer and activity, followed by lessons for the children and a chance for parents to meet with a priest or leader to discuss our faith.
- Parents work with children to complete approximately 20 Home sessions using parent-friendly materials and instructions.
- Any family member who would like a shared faith experience can participate. Parents, children, grandparents, step-parents, aunts, uncles – all are welcome.
