

Summer Reading

I mentioned last weekend that all the priests of the Archdiocese will be attending a special summit in October. It will be led by Father Mallon, the author of *Divine Renovation*. His book and the summit will be examining how we move from maintaining what is, to how we grow as a parish by focusing on making disciples, building church, and serving others.

It's not as if we aren't doing those things now. But perhaps those things can be done with greater intensity and intentionality. If you are interested in learning more about this, obtain a copy of *Divine Renovation*.

There are a number of other books tackling this subject matter of renewing and revitalizing our parishes. There's an entire series addressing Church of the Nativity, which serves Luther-ville and Timonium in Maryland. The pastor took a sleepy moderate-sized parish and transformed it into a booming operation. The first book in the series is *Rebuilt* by Michael White and Tom Corcoran. Next in the series is *Tools for Rebuilding* (same authors). Other books in this same series are *Rebuilding Your Message* (same authors), *Rebuilding Youth Ministry* and *Rebuilding Confirmation* both by Christopher Wesley. All of the *Rebuilt* books are published by Ave Maria Press.

Joe Paprocki has written A Church on the Move: 52 Ways to Get Mission and Mercy in Motion (Loyola Press, Chicago).

Sherry A. Weddell has written *Forming Intentional Disciples:* The Path to Knowing and Following Jesus (Our Sunday Visitor Publishing Division).

Another interesting book is authored by Louis J. Cameli, a priest of the Archdiocese: *Church, Faith, Future: What We Face, What We Can Do* (Liturgical Press, Collegeville, MN).

Those who are Bold, Have at It!

All these books are very interesting and provocative. They provide interesting ideas and propose solutions to revitalizing parish and Church in our very secularized North America.

All of this is grist for the mill, as we strategize over our own future in this new parish of ours. Just some light summer reading!



Renew My Church

Our *Renew My Church* journey is both spiritual (to re-encounter Jesus Christ as disciples and parish communities) and structural (to ensure our parishes have adequate resources for vitality).

Why the need for spiritual renewal?

We are facing not an "age of change" but a "change for the ages."

What is the fundamental change needed for a truly renewed Church?

Making sure that everything we do is implicitly and explicitly rooted in helping people know and share Jesus Christ. This involves change, or conversion, on three levels:

- Personal: Our own, personal encounter with Christ through which we become missionary disciples.
- Parish: Sharing with each other the life we have experienced in encountering Christ. This means taking responsibility for the building up of the parish as a

- Against faith
- Clear understanding of Christian imagination and language

- Foundational moral teaching
- Rejected moral teaching
- Christians in majority
- Christians in minority

community of faith, starting with the need to cooperate and collaborate as your parish prepares for and eventually becomes activated in the Renew My Church process within your grouping.

 Archdiocese: The Cardinal and his staff are responsible for providing vision, resources, and support necessary to lead people and communities to authentic relationship with Christ.

THE IMPORTANCE OF THIS PRAYER FOR THE FUTURE OF DIVINE MERCY PARISH

The staff of Divine Mercy Parish gathered together for a retreat during the last week of June, so that we might be more spiritually united as we help lead parishioners through the changes and transition that Renew My Church brings. One part of the retreat focused on this prayer. We each individually spent a great deal of time in prayer on this prayer, and were to focus on one line or insight that we garnered from the prayer.

We then came together as a group, and were given direction by our facilitator to use the creative side of our brains to express that insight in a drawing. So, we each sat down with markers, crayons and colored pencils to draw something that might express the insight to which each of us was drawn! We laughed a lot at our (lack of) artistic abilities!

It was clear the Holy Spirit was in our midst! We each presented our drawings and shared what "spoke to us" from the Renew My Church prayer. Many spoke of the handing on our gifts to future generations. Others discussed imagining our future boldly. Some connected to staying together in charity and remaining in the holy company of the Blessed Virgin Mary. One person focused on the entire first paragraph because of the call to those who have gone before us, and that we renew our Church in every age. Others focused on the peace necessary to undergo this process. We all need to be at peace in our hearts and open minded for Renew My Church to be truly successful.

This *exercise* had such a profound effect on all of us, that we would like everyone in the parish to spend some time with this prayer. Read through it several times, even out loud to yourself. Think about the following:

What speaks to you, or jumps out at you about this prayer? What does the Holy Spirit want you to notice? How will you embrace the sentiments of this prayer as a member of Divine Mercy Parish? How will you internalize this spirit of renewal? How will you contribute towards the Renew My Church efforts at Divine Mercy?
