

FROM THE PASTOR'S PEN

DRIVE-IN MASS

Growing up in a small town in Ohio I felt pretty blest. We had two movie theatres! There were a whole bunch of Saturday or Sunday afternoons when we kids in our neighborhood were each given a dollar by our moms to send us off to the movie theatre. I suppose they wanted a break from us kids running around the neighborhood like wild Indians (which we did a lot).

There was a outdoor drive-in movie theatre just outside of town but it didn't usually show first run films. I have a vague recollection of attending one showing at the drive-in during our Senior ditch days just before graduating from high school, one of the many class activities organized in that week. I think it was a monster movie. Fun!

I mention this because we just celebrated our first drive-in Mass at the St. Philip Church parking lot last Sunday early evening. This Mass kicked off the start of the new year of Children's Ministry. Families drove in and stayed in their cars, listening to Mass on an FM channel and viewing the altar area through their windshields.

Wow! Singing to the Beat of the Band!

During Mass I was chuckling. The young kids in the car directly in front of the altar were clearly singing along with the musicians; at least, they seemed to be doing so given their enthusiastic body language. But, of course, I couldn't hear them. Their windows were rolled up.

If only we could get people to sing like that in church. Not now, when we can't engage in assembly singing. But once this pandemic is past, I hope some of the excitement of a drive-in Mass translates to in-church experiences.

Why shouldn't it? Just because we're

in church doesn't mean that we lose our enthusiasm or act in such a way that folks do not see the joy of salvation as we pray and worship. It is **Good** News, you know!

Even our Four-Footed Friends Joined In

Last Sunday's drive-in Mass was delightful, and I hope that we will be able to continue the practice from time to time even as the weather gets colder. I especially liked seeing the family pets (all canine, I didn't see any cats or other pets).

Dogs take more easily to cars than do cats. Although, I have to say that a few dogs did take issue with me sprinkling them with Holy Water!

Last Sunday was the Feast day of St. Francis of Assisi, so as we handed out bags which contained the materials for Children's Ministry, I lobbed in a few drops from the Holy Water bucket on whatever pet pooch was inside the car with the family. Some of the expressions on those pet's faces were priceless, they were quite surprised!

I am so grateful to everyone who made this unique Mass go so smooth, especially Kathy Handelman who is the Coordinator of our Children's Ministry. God bless the many volunteers who pitched in to make that drive-in Family Mass successful.

We had adults and youth who directed cars as they got situated in the parking lot, a ton of music ministers on hand to raise a joyful noise to the Lord, a sound technician so that we could be heard in the parking lot and inside all those vehicles via car radios, maintenance folks who set up the altar area, liturgical ministers to help with Communion, and staff people who organized and helped with all the odds and ends of the celebration and



the informational packets.

Divine Mercy Parish has a reputation for its generosity and service to others. Thank you for sticking with it through this pandemic! We continue to hear thanks from our many outreach partners, including the New Trier Township Food Pantry, A Just Harvest Community Kitchen, Connections for the Homeless, St. Benedict the African and St. Columbanus, as well as their school Augustus Tolton Catholic Academy. They are so grateful for your help!

We also want to share news from The Women's Center, particularly during this month of October, known as Respect Life Month. The Women's Center has inaugurated *The Virtual* Baby Bottle Project to raise essential funds for the Women's Center. The Women's Center is dedicated to saving the lives of unborn children threatened by abortion through the most effective, morally acceptable means of reaching, informing and helping their mothers and families with appropriate loving alternatives. You can visit www.gotwc.org to make a donation. The Women's Center also seeks donations to their "Family Room."

They are in need of 20 to 40 lb car seats, infant car seat/carriers (by law all car seats must be less than 7 years old), high chairs, strollers, baby carriers, pack n plays, toddler beds, cribs (no drop down sides), exersaucers and baby swings. There is a great need for baby food and all brands of baby formula (especially Enfamil Formula in the yellow box). Also needed are diapers in sizes 4, 5 and 6 only; diaper bags, receiving blankets, new pacifiers, baby wipes, baby shampoo, lotion, and breast pumps.
