Our Confirmation Candidates will be confirmed with the newly blessed Sacred Chism on April 15 with Bishop Jeffrey Grob.

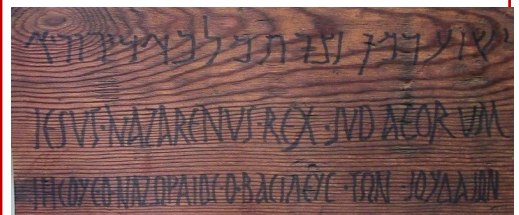


## LITURGY AND LIFE

**What Is I.N.R.I. on the Crucifix?**

Above the crucifix at St. Philip the Apostle church you notice the abbreviation INRI. This is an abbreviation for *Jesus Nazarenus, Rex Judeorum* — Jesus of Nazareth, King of the Jews. In Latin the "I" and "J" are usually interchangeable and ancient Latin did not use the "J." That is why it is I.N.R.I. not J.N.R.J. It was common for the Romans to hang a "titulus" or sign above the crucified to indicate the charges against him.

Scripture says that Pilate put the charges in Latin, Greek and Hebrew. Pilate placed this title above Jesus in scorn and mockery, rather than faith. He also likely knew it would irritate the Jewish leaders, which it did (see Jn 19:21). Yet even in his ridicule, Pilate spoke truth. Jesus is King, not of the Jews only, but of all things.

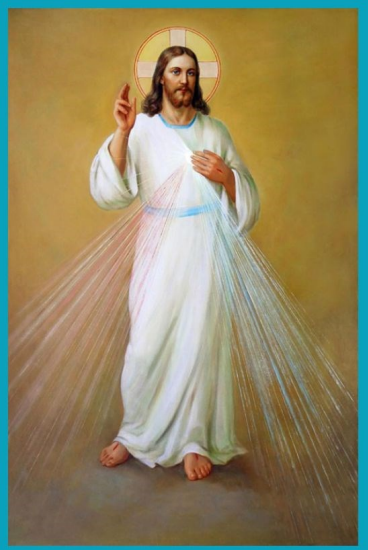

Join Fr. Corey Brost, CSV, on Thursday, April 11th at 7 p.m. in the Parish Center to learn about the *Viator House of Hospitality*, and volunteer opportunities available to Divine Mercy parishioners.

**Who are they and what do they do?**

"Viator House of Hospitality provides compassionate accompaniment of young adult male immigrants seeking asylum." It was established in January of 2017, and provides a humane and fiscally-responsible alternative to immigration detention with a supportive living environment where young men can attend school, improve their language skills, grow spiritually and emotionally, receive medical attention, and work while they await immigration proceedings and for some time after winning those proceedings.

local community on a regular basis at area agencies that serve the poor locally and internationally. Since its founding in 2017, Viator House of Hospitality has provided a home for more than 90 young men from 22 nations.

Viator House also engages in education about the U.S. asylum system and advocates for changes to make that system more humane, while supporting the development of similar hospitality houses across the country.

**How do volunteers make a difference?**

Volunteers help VHH participants adapt to life in the U.S. in many ways. Among other things, they help young men learn English, succeed in school, learn to cook, get to work or back home, plan their finances and search for cars or apartments. Most importantly, volunteers help replace the family and friends our participants have left behind.
