#### PASTOR'S "TO THE POINT"



I usually stick to one point in this column, hence the title. However, this weekend I've got two things I'd like to share with you.

First, Father Matt O'Donnell, pastor of Saint Moses the Black Parish, visits Sacred Heart church this weekend, presiding and preaching at those three Masses. He's here as the final piece to the *Legacy of the Heart* capital campaign, an initiative of the former parish prior to the merger.

Those of you who were around back when the *Legacy of the Heart* campaign took place might remember that it included funds earmarked for Saint Moses (then St. Columbanus Parish). Fr. Matt will talk about life at Saint Moses and how some of those *Legacy* funds have been utilized, especially with their Athletic Center.

Secondly, I'd like to highlight and literally point you to the facing page. You'll see a snapshot of our parish based on the *Disciple Maker Index* survey taken in all the parishes of the Archdiocese this past Lent.

The survey will be taken again in a few years. This will allow each parish to determine how parishioners are progressing in discipleship.

During the first quarter of 2023, the parishioners of Divine Mercy were asked to participate in the Archdiocesan-wide Disciple Maker Index Survey, which gave people an opportunity to reflect on their spiritual growth, level of involvement in the parish, as well as their satisfaction with the parish and parish related activities. Approximately 54 percent of our active\* parishioners completed the survey. (That's 235 completed surveys out of 435 average weekend mass-goers.) Thank you for taking the time to share your thoughts. We appreciate your efforts in providing the parish with valuable insights into how we can enhance our faith and service-based community. Below is a brief overview of the survey findings. ### PARISH STRENGTHS

Based on the survey data, we have identified our top parish strengths. The following percentages show those who answered "agree or strongly agree" for each question.

90%

87%

believe that the Eucharist is the Body and Blood of Christ.

86%

feel our parish communicates well and makes information readily available. make time daily or weekly for individual prayer time.

attend Mass weekly, with some attending daily.

understand that the Church is critical to their relationship with God.

We will strengthen our **missionary discipleship** by enabling parishioners to share their personal witness stories, helping them feel confident to have a conversation about faith with family and friends, and inviting another person to a parish activity or Mass.




